ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On February 21, 2017, Plaintiff, an inmate at Kern Valley State Prison, filed a *pro se* civil rights complaint under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff also filed an order dated January 27, 2017, from the United States District Court for the Eastern District of California, in which Plaintiff was authorized to proceed *in forma pauperis* ("IFP") in a habeas proceeding.
