REMANDING CASE**


Re: Dkt. No. 7

On March 23, 2017, Magistrate Judge Kandis A. Westmore granted defendant's application to proceed *in forma pauperis* and issued a Report and Recommendation recommending that this unlawful detainer case be remanded to San Mateo County Superior Court for lack of jurisdiction. Dkt. No. 7.

Objections to Judge Westmore's recommendation were due by April 10, 2017. Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 72(b); Civ. Local Rule 72-3. As of today's date, no objections have been filed.¹ Having reviewed the Report and Recommendation, as well as the record in this case, I ADOPT Judge Westmore's Report and Recommendation in full. This case is REMANDED to San Mateo County Superior Court for lack of jurisdiction.
