The issues in defendants' motion to dismiss are closely related to their alleged basis for removal, and the Court will benefit from reviewing the briefing on both motions before ruling on either one, if not hearing argument on both simultaneously. Accordingly, plaintiffs' motion to stay is **DENIED**. This is without prejudice to a stipulation setting a schedule for full briefing and oral argument on both motions simultaneously.
