16	The <i>pro hac vice</i> application of Attorney Fidelma Fitzpatrick (Dkt. No. 30) is DENIED for
17	failing to comply with Local Rule 11-3. The local rule requires that an applicant certify that "he
18	or she is an active member in good standing of the bar of a United States <i>Court</i> or of <i>the highest</i>
19	<i>court</i> of another State or the District of Columbia, <i>specifying such bar</i> " (emphasis added).
20	Filling out the <i>pro hac vice</i> form from the district court website such that it only identifies the
21	state of bar membership — such as "the bar of Rhode Island" — is inadequate under the local
22	rule because it fails to identify a specific court. While the application fee does not need to be
22 23	paid again, the application cannot be processed until a corrected form is submitted.
24 25	IT IS SO ORDERED.
