19 WHEREAS, on October 23, 2017, the Court issued a minute order (Dkt. No. 38) taking  
 20 Defendant's Motion to Compel Arbitration ("Motion") under submission and vacating the  
 21 October 26, 2017 hearing for that Motion;

22 WHEREAS, on November 2, 2017, the parties filed a Stipulation (Dkt. No. 39) to vacate  
 23 the November 9, 2017 Case Management Conference ("CMC"), in light of the Court's  
 24 forthcoming ruling on Defendant's Motion;

25 WHEREAS, the Court vacated the November 9, 2017 CMC and continued the CMC to  
 26 December 21, 2017 (Dkt. No. 40);

27 WHEREAS, on November 29, 2017, the parties filed a Stipulation (Dkt. No. 41) to  
 28 continue the CMC further, by approximately 30 days;

1           WHEREAS, on November 29, 2017, the Court continued the CMC from December 21,  
2 2017 to January 25, 2018 (Dkt. No. 42);

3           WHEREAS, Defendant's Motion remains under submission and there has been no  
4 decision from the Court;

5           WHEREAS, should the Court grant Defendant's Motion, the parties anticipate that this  
6 action will be stayed pending the outcome of an arbitration proceeding;

7           WHEREAS, if the Court denies the Motion, Defendant reserves the right to take an appeal  
8 pursuant to the Federal Arbitration Act and to seek a stay of this action pending the appeal;

9           WHEREAS, the parties' Joint Case Management Statement is currently due on January  
10 18, 2018;

11           WHEREAS, the parties believe that Defendant's Motion should be resolved prior to the  
12 initial CMC and submission of the CMC Statement;

13           WHEREAS, the parties have met and conferred and agree that, in the interest of judicial  
14 economy, the CMC should be continued by approximately 60 days, to provide additional time for  
15 the Court to issue a ruling on Defendant's Motion;

16           IT IS THEREFORE STIPULATED by and between the parties through their respective  
17 counsel as follows:

18           1.       The January 25, 2018 CMC shall be continued to March 29, 2018, or the next date  
19 available for the Court.

20           2.       The parties shall file a joint CMC Statement on or before March 22, 2018.
