WHEREAS, a complaint is being filed simultaneously with this ~~[Proposed]~~ Order by which Plaintiff-in-Limitation YACHTING SPECIALTIES, INC. ("Plaintiff-in-Limitation"), as owner of vessel M/V ASSIST GOLDEN GATE (CF No. 4515CG) ("VESSEL"), wherein Plaintiff-in-Limitation seeks exoneration from or limitation of liability for any losses, injuries, and/or damages occasioned as a result of the VESSEL voyage on or about March 8, 2015, in the Pacific Ocean off the coast of San Francisco, California; and

WHEREAS, the complaint having stated the facts and circumstances upon which said exoneration or limitation is claimed; and

WHEREAS, it appearing that the claims that may be made against Plaintiff-in-Limitation may be in amounts which will exceed the value of the interest of Plaintiff-in-Limitation in the VESSEL for losses, injuries, and/or damages said to have been occasioned or incurred in consequence of the aforesaid voyage; and

1 AND IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the publication and mailing of copies of the
2 Notice to Claimants, required by Rule F(4), Supplemental Rules for Certain Admiralty and
3 Maritime Claims, Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, shall constitute due notice to all persons
4 asserting claims with respect to which said complaint seeks limitation or exoneration.
