ORDER DIRECTING DEFENDANT FLAGSTAR BANK FSB TO SUBMIT CHAMBERS COPIES IN COMPLIANCE WITH CIVIL LOCAL RULES AND COURT'S STANDING ORDERS

Flagstar is hereby advised that if it fails in the future to comply with the Court's Standing Orders to provide a chambers copy of each electronically filed document, the Court may impose sanctions, including, but not limited to, striking from the record any electronically filed document for which a chambers copy has not been timely provided to the Court.
