CHAMBERS COPIES IN COMPLIANCE

Flagstar is hereby advised that if it fails in the future to comply with the Court's Standing Orders to provide a chambers copy of each electronically filed document, the Court may impose sanctions, including, but not limited to, striking from the record any electronically filed document for which a chambers copy has not been timely provided to the Court.
