15	Plaintiff, a prisoner with sight disabilities at the Los Angeles County Jail,
16	has filed a prose civil action alleging violations of his federal rights under 42
17	U.S.C. § 1983 and Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, 42
18	U.S.C.§ 12101 et seq. (ADA), at the jails and sheriff's offices of San Bernardino
19	and Los Angeles counties.
20	Plaintiff first filed this action on March 15, 2017, but it was transferred to
21	the Central District of California because the alleged violations took place, and
22	plaintiff and most of the defendants reside in, the Central District. See Brown v.
23	Brown, No. C 17-1412 NJV (N.D. Cal. Apr. 20, 2017) (order of transfer). But
24	plaintiff has re-filed it as a new case because he now seeks to intervene in this
25	district's pending class action in Armstrong v. Brown, No. C 94-2307 CW (N.D.
26	Cal. filed June 29, 1994). Plaintiff apparently wants to benefit from the permanent
27	injunction and remedial plan that Judge Wilken has entered in connection with the
28	Armstrong case by having that injunction and remedial plan, which apply to

1	disabled prisoners in the custody of the California Department of Corrections and
2	Rehabilitation (CDCR), extended to disabled prisoners in the custody of the state's
3	county sheriffs as well.
4	This court cannot grant plaintiff in the instant individual action the
5	extraordinary relief he seeks. Plaintiff must pursue the expansion/modification of
6	the injunction and remedial plan in the <u>Armstrong</u> class action by way of a motion
7	in the <u>Armstrong</u> class action itself.
8	
	Plaintiff's prisoner civil action is DISMISSED under the authority of 28
9	U.S.C. § 1915A without prejudice to his filing a motion for relief in the <u>Armstrong</u>
10	class action.
11	The clerk is instructed to terminate all motions as moot and close the file.
