5	("CMC"), currently scheduled for September 19, 2017, to November 8, 2017, at 2:00 p.m., the			
6	same date of the hearing on the Rule 12 motions, subject to the availability of the Court. The			
7	Parties understand that the Court ordinarily holds CMCs on Tuesdays, but certain counsel for the			
8	Parties will be traveling to San Francisco for the hearing and CMC, including from the East Coast,			
9	and Plaintiffs and Defendants believe this would be the most efficient option for both the Court			
10	and the Parties' counsel.			
11	Plaintiffs and the CSU Defendants previously requested an extension of time with			
12	respect to the filing and service of oppositions and replies with regard to Defendants' Rule 12
