18 The above entitled Plaintiff having filed its complaint herein, and the above entitled
 19 defendant having consented to the making and entry of this final judgment without trial,
 20 hereby agree as follows:

21 1. This Court has jurisdiction over the subject matter of this litigation and over the
 22 parties to the Consent Judgment. The Complaint herein states a claim upon which relief
 23 can be granted. The defendant hereby acknowledges and accepts service of the
 24 complaint filed herein.

25 2. In accordance with the provisions of Title 28 U.S.C. Section 636(c) the parties
 26 hereby voluntarily waive their rights to proceed before a judge of the United States District
 27 Court and consent to have a United States Magistrate Judge conduct any and all further
 28 proceedings in the case, including trial, and order the entry of a final judgment. It is

1 understood that any appeal from a judgment entered by a Magistrate Judge will be taken
2 directly to the Ninth Circuit of the United States Court of Appeals in the same manner as
3 an appeal from any other judgment of a District Court.

4 3. Judgment shall be in favor of Plaintiff, United States of America, and against
5 defendant, BONITA N. NIELSEN aka BONITA NADINE NIELSEN aka BONITA
6 NIELSEN, in the sum of \$17,001.60 consisting of \$15,112.41 in principal, \$1,824.19
7 interest to October 13, 2017, CIF costs of \$0.00, court costs of \$65.00 and attorney's fees
8 of \$0.00, plus interest at the rate of 2.500% per annum (\$1.035 per day) on principal in
9 the amount of \$15,112.41 from October 13, 2017, up to the date of entry of this Consent
10 Judgment, less any sums tendered toward satisfaction of the obligation during said time
11 period.

12 4. This consent judgment shall bear interest pursuant to the provisions of 28
13 U.S.C §1961(a) at the legal rate per annum from the date of entry of judgment, which
14 interest will be compounded annually pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. §1961(b)
15 until paid in full.

16 5. Defendant shall pay \$475.00 monthly, subject to a 10 day grace period,
17 commencing October 25, 2017, and continuing monthly htereafter, each payment being
18 due on the 25th day of each succeeding month, until the account is paid in full.

19 6. Payments shall be made payable to the United States Department of Justice
20 and bear defendant's name and CDCS # 2017A65811 and mailed to,

25 until the account is paid in full.

26 7. (a) Each said payment shall be applied first to the payment of costs and then
27 to interest accrued to the date of receipt of said payment, and the balance, if any, to the
28 principal;

(b) The judgment debtor shall submit financial data to the plaintiff as specified

1 by plaintiff on the anniversary date of this judgment for each year this judgment remains
2 unpaid; and

3 (c) Plaintiff reserves the right to evaluate the updated financial data and adjust
4 the periodic payment rate accordingly, or to demand a lump sum payment if warranted
5 by the judgment debtor's financial circumstances, subject to Court approval.

6 8. An Abstract of Judgment shall be recorded with the Recorder's Office of the
7 County of residence of the judgment debtor; plaintiff may also record or file similar
8 documents elsewhere; defendant shall be charged with cost of recordings.
9 Notwithstanding any pay plan contained in this document or any subsequent pay plan,
10 upon its receipt of a request for demand pursuant to its abstract of judgment, the United
11 States intends to collect the full balance due on this debt pursuant to its demand for full
12 payoff.

13 9. Default under the terms of this consent judgment will entitle the United States
14 of America to execute on this judgment without notice to the judgment debtor.

15 10. The judgment debtor has the right of prepayment of this debt without penalty,
16 and the interest charged will only be calculated to the date of final payment.

17 11. In case of default, all costs incurred in recording, filing, executing, or levying
18 on, satisfying, or otherwise servicing this judgment shall be paid by the judgment debtor.

19 12. Upon a change of address of record for the defendant, defendant shall report
20 the new address to the court and to counsel for plaintiff.
