
Before the Court is plaintiff LegalForce RAPC Worldwide, P.C.'s Administrative Motion, filed September 17, 2018, "to Request that the Court Dismiss Case in View of Appeal." Defendant LegalZoom.com, Inc. has filed opposition.

Having read and considered the parties' respective submissions, the Court, for the reasons stated by defendant (see Def.'s Opp. at 1:9-26), finds the relief sought by plaintiff is not properly sought in a motion for administrative relief.
