ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE TO PLAINTIFF RE: FAILURE TO FILE MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT

Plaintiff Joseph Bond Simpson filed this action challenging the denial of his application for social security benefits. On September 12, 2018, the Court granted Plaintiff's motion for an extension of time, until October 19, 2018, to file his motion for summary judgment. (Dkt. No. 13.)
