14 The clerk opened this case on June 24, 2020, based upon a letter from petitioner, a
15 California prisoner, complaining about his confinement. The same day, the clerk notified
16 petitioner that in order to proceed with his case, he must file a petition and either pay the filing
17 fee or file an application to proceed in forma pauperis ("IFP") within 28 days. Along with the
18 notices, the clerk mailed him a form habeas petition and IFP application, instructions for
19 completing these forms, and stamped return envelopes. The notices cautioned petitioner that he
20 must return the completed forms within 28 days or the case would be dismissed. No response
21 has been received. Accordingly, the case is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.

22 The Clerk shall enter judgment and close the file.
