5	or claiming to act on their behalf, are permanently enjoined from advertising, selling, distributing, manufacturing, or displaying any of
6	Plaintiffs' products or from advertising, selling, distributing, manufacturing, or displaying any products which bear Plaintiffs'
7	trademarks.
8	The Clerk is directed to enter judgment consistent with this order and close the file in this
9	matter.
