

**ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE**

On July 11, 2024, an order granting the motion to dismiss the complaint was issued in this matter. Plaintiffs were granted leave to amend within 30 days of that order, correlating with a deadline of August 10, 2024. No amendment was filed by that date.
