13 Plaintiffs John Armstrong, et al., move to shorten time on the  
14 impending motion to compel of Defendants Edmund G. Brown, Jr., et  
15 al.<sup>1</sup> Defendants oppose Plaintiffs' motion to shorten time.  
16 Plaintiffs also move for leave to file a reply in support of their  
17 motion to shorten time and for a telephonic status conference.

18 The Court GRANTS Plaintiffs' motion to file a reply in support  
19 of their motion to shorten time (Docket No. 1833) and GRANTS in  
20 part their motion to shorten time (Docket No. 1828). If Defendants  
21 wish to file a motion to compel, they must do so by February 16,  
22 2011 in a brief not to exceed five pages. Plaintiffs' opposition  
23 to Defendants' motion to compel and their cross-motion for a  
24 protective order, if they wish to so move, shall be due February

Schwarzenegger as Governor of California.


1 22, 2011 and be contained in a brief not to exceed five pages.  
2 Defendants' reply in support of their motion to compel and  
3 opposition to any cross-motion for a protective order shall be due  
4 February 24, 2011 and be contained in a brief not to exceed two  
5 pages. The motions will not be referred to a magistrate judge; the  
6 Court will decide the motions on the papers.

7 In accordance with the Court's Order of January 5, 2011,  
8 Defendants' opposition to Plaintiffs' Motion to Compel Compensation  
9 at Plaintiffs' Counsel's Reasonable 2010 Hourly Rates is due March  
10 8, 2011. This deadline will not be extended. If necessary and if  
11 they are granted additional discovery, Defendants will be allowed  
12 to supplement their opposition. Plaintiffs' reply is due March 21,  
13 2011. This motion will be decided on the papers.

14 The Court DENIES Plaintiffs' motion for a telephonic status  
15 conference regarding the parties' current discovery disputes.  
16 (Docket No. 1834.) A status conference will be held March 1, 2011  
17 at 1:30 p.m.
