Petitioner's other 14 counsel, John R Grele, states that he is prepared to continue his 15 appointed representation of Petitioner. 16 Because Petitioner is financially unable to obtain adequate 17 representation and the interests of justice so require, the Court 18 appoints Mr. Grele under the Criminal Justice Act to represent 19 Petitioner on the above-entitled federal habeas petition.
