Plaintiff filed a response on 19 November 10, 2010. Having considered all of the parties' 20 submissions, the Court vacates the motion hearing set for December 21 2, 2010 at 2:00 pm, and orders the following. 22 The length of the trial is extended to fourteen days, which 23 includes time for jury selection and arguments. The trial start date remains the same, October 31, 2011. The Court 24 informs the parties that the trial in the present case trails a felony criminal trial which will take priority. 25 Trial time will be divided equally between the parties. 26 The Court will not permit more than one expert witness per 27 side per subject matter.
