

On March 21, 2011, the Ninth Circuit issued its judgment reversing and remanding this Court's July 20, 2009 Order, which granted Defendant's motion for relief from the Court's Amended Judgment of April 3, 2009, Docket No. 428, to the extent that the Amended Judgment awarded pre- and post-judgment interest. On May 23, 2011, the Ninth Circuit's judgment took effect following the issuance of a formal mandate under Rule 41(a) of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure.
