- (4) Following the four-week stay, Magistrate Judge Nandor Vadas will set a scheduling conference to set a date for settlement proceedings.
- (5) If this case does not settle, the parties shall appear for a Case Management Conference on **Monday, May 8, 2017 at 2:00 p.m.**, at the United States District Court for the Northern District of California, Ronald V. Dellums Federal Building, Oakland in Courtroom 1, 4th Floor.
- (6) At least seven (7) calendar days prior to the Case Management Conference, the parties shall file a joint case management conference statement. The statement must include all elements requested in the "Standing Order for All Judges of the Northern District of California Contents of Joint Case Management Statement." See http://www.cand.uscourts.gov/ygrorders. As set forth in the Court's Standing Order in Civil Cases, these conferences are intended to be substantive and productive. Accordingly, each party shall be represented at the Case Management Conference by counsel with authority to enter into stipulations and make admissions pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 16(a) and (c), as well as fully prepared to address all of the matters referred to in the CAND CMC Order and Civil L.R. 16-10(b). Failure to do so may be considered grounds for sanctions.
- (7) The Clerk shall send a copy of this Order to Mr. Melendez and Ms. Rutledge at Cozen O'Connor, 101 Montgomery Street, Suite 1400, San Francisco, California 94104. The Clerk shall also send a copy of this Order to Plaintiff and Defendants' counsel.
