**STATUS REPORT, STIPULATION
EXTENDING TIME AND ORDER
EXTENDING TIME**

1 On July 14, 2008, the parties to the above-captioned matters informed this Court that they
2 had reached a settlement in principle. On July 29, 2008, this Court entered an Order setting a thirty-
3 five (35) day deadline to finalize the settlement. The parties have been working toward finalizing
4 the settlement. The parties' current understanding is that only minor details remain to be resolved,
5 and it is anticipated that a settlement agreement will be executed shortly. The settlement agreement
6 provides that a final stipulated dismissal would be filed with the Court three (3) business days after a
7 certain event occurring up to ten (10) business days after execution of the agreement. In view of the
8 foregoing, the parties agree that the thirty-five day (35) period set in the July 29, 2008 Order should
9 be extended to accommodate final resolution of the remaining issues and extended to include the
10 thirteen-business-day contingency period set forth in the settlement agreement. Therefore, it is
11 hereby stipulated and agreed between the parties:

12 1. That the thirty-five day time period set forth in paragraph 2 of the Court's July 29, 2008
13 Order shall be extended by fifteen (15) business days from the date of this Stipulation.
