2	DIB 82-03 with	respect to the issue the accessibility of highway shoulders intended for pedestrian
3	use.	

4 4. The parties shall file the two aforementioned stipulations and the certification of
5 counsel by no later Noon on Wednesday, September 23, 2009. The stipulations and certification
6 may be submitted separately or in a single document.

7 5. The parties are ordered to appear before Magistrate Judge Elizabeth LaPorte for a
8 further mandatory settlement conference on Tuesday, September 22, 2009, at 1:30 p.m. at 450
9 Golden Gate Ave., San Francisco, California 94102. The parties are directed to comply with any
10 further orders issued by Judge LaPorte in connection with those settlement proceedings.

11 6. Trial in this action is in recess and shall resume on Monday, October 5, 2009 at 8:30
12 a.m.
