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21 Upon consideration of Defendant Palm, Inc.'s emergency motion to compel deposition and
 22 for sanctions, the Court finds that Defendant is entitled to seven hours to depose Jessica Weeks as
 23 Plaintiff Helio LLC's Rule 30(b)(6) designee. Plaintiff is therefore ordered to immediately
 24 produce Ms. Weeks for the remainder of her deposition. Plaintiff is further ordered to pay
 25 Defendant's reasonable fees and costs associated with bringing its motion to compel, as well as
 26 the costs of completing Ms. Weeks' deposition.

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Defendant's papers in opposition to Plaintiff's motion for a preliminary injunction shall be due on March 27, 2007. Plaintiff's reply papers shall be due on April 3, 2007. The preliminary injunction hearing shall be on April 17, 2007 at 1:00 p.m.
