10 The Court is in receipt of the parties' notice of availability for a courtroom meet and confer
 11 session. Based on the parties' availability, the Court hereby ORDERS the parties to meet and
 12 confer, in person, on November 2, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. in Courtroom B, located on the 15th Floor of
 13 the Federal Building, 450 Golden Gate Avenue, San Francisco, California 94102.

14 At the meet and confer session, the parties should come prepared to meaningfully discuss
 15 and resolve their outstanding discovery dispute(s). In the event that the parties are unable to resolve
 16 their disputes, they shall draft a joint letter at the meet and confer session in compliance with this
 17 Court's standing order, and said letter shall be presented by the parties for filing at the conclusion of
 18 the session. Thus, the parties are ORDERED to bring with them one laptop and an auxiliary storage
 19 medium, such as a USB port thumb drive, to use in drafting said letter. The parties are advised that
 20 they will not meet with the undersigned during or after the meet and confer session.

21 However, if the parties are able to meet and confer in person and resolve their disputes or file
 22 any necessary joint meet and confer letters prior to the meet and confer session, the parties shall
 23 jointly request that the Court vacate the date.
