7 8	opposing party shall submit a response as soon as possible but no later than four days after service.
9	If the modification sought is an extension of a deadline contained herein, the motion must be brought <u>before</u> expiration of that deadline. The parties may not modify the pretrial
10	schedule by stipulation. A conflict with a court date set after the date of this order does not constitute good cause. The parties are advised that if they stipulate to a change in the discovery schedule, they do so at their own risk. The only discovery schedule that the court will enforce
11	is the one set in this order.
