Defendant/Counterclaimant 22 PGE was to file a motion to confirm arbitration award for severance 23 payments by January 22, 2009 and notice the motion for hearing on 24 March 5, 2009. To date, parties have not set the case for a 25 settlement conference nor filed a motion to confirm arbitration 26 award for severance payments. Accordingly, 27

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the declaration above-mentioned 4 shall set forth in factual summary the nature of the case, its 5 present status, and the expected future course of the case if it is 6 not dismissed.

7 Failure to comply with this order will be deemed a sufficient 8 ground for sanctions, including dismissal of counterclaims for 9 failure to prosecute.
