The Ninth Circuit recently made clear that a state prisoner challenging the administrative decision by the Board to deny his request for parole need not obtain a certificate of appealability. See Rosas v. Nielsen, 428 F.3d 1229, 1232 (9th Cir. 2005).

The Clerk of the Court shall process the notice of appeal.
