11           Petitioner Larry D. Peterson has filed a petition for a writ  
12 of habeas corpus. Respondent Stu Sherman moves to dismiss,  
13 arguing that Peterson failed to exhaust some of his claims and  
14 that all of his claims are procedurally defaulted. In response,  
15 Peterson asserts that he has been denied copies of trial  
16 transcripts and other documents in the state trial and appellate  
17 record. Opposition at 1-2; see Docket No. 12, Order Denying  
18 Motion to Dismiss at 2-3, 15.

19           The Court hereby orders that the Attorney General of the  
20 State of California file with the Court and serve upon Peterson  
21 within thirty days of the issuance of this Order a copy of all  
22 trial and appellate records that have been transcribed for the  
23 underlying conviction in this case.

24           After receiving the records, Peterson may file a supplemental  
25 opposition to Sherman's Motion to Dismiss. If Peterson wishes to  
26 do so, he shall file his supplemental opposition within thirty  
27 days of his receipt of the records.
