Michael Mullins and Stephan R. Passalacqua. Rule 41(a) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure provides that a plaintiff may, without a either: 1) a notice of dismissal before the defendant serves an

16 17 18 19 20 court order, dismiss all claims against a defendant only by filing 21 22 answer or a motion or summary judgment; or 2) a stipulation of 23 dismissal signed by all parties who have appeared. Otherwise, a 24 court order is required. Mr. Mullins and Mr. Passalacqua have both 25 answered the complaint. Plaintiff therefore may not dismiss his 26 claims against these Defendants by filing a notice of dismissal. 27 Accordingly, the notice of dismissal (Docket No. 119) is STRICKEN. 28 If Plaintiff wishes to dismiss his claims against Mr. Mullins and

1	Mr. Passalacqua, he must either file a stipulation of dismissal or,
2	if Defendants will not agree to a stipulation, move the Court for
3	an order of dismissal.
