10 Plaintiff Isaiah Noel Williams, a state prisoner, filed this
11 pro se civil rights action under 42 U.S.C. § 1983 concerning events
12 that occurred at Pelican Bay State Prison in 2006. On March 29,
13 2012, the Court granted in part and denied in part Defendant's
14 motion for summary judgment and referred the matter to Magistrate
15 Judge Nandor Vadas for a settlement conference. Id. The Court has
16 been informed that the case did not settle. Consequently, the case
17 will proceed to trial.

18 Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff is
19 referred to the Federal Pro Bono Project of the Volunteer Legal
20 Services Program, which will attempt to find an attorney who is
21 able to represent Plaintiff in these proceedings.

22 Accordingly,

23 1. The Clerk of the Court shall forward electronically to the
24 Federal Pro Bono Project: (a) a copy of this order, (b) a copy of
25 the docket sheet, and (c) a copy of the operative complaint (docket
26 no. 1) and the Court's order denying the motion for summary
27 judgment (docket no. 82).

28 2. If an attorney can be found to represent Plaintiff,

1 that attorney shall be appointed as counsel for Plaintiff in this
2 matter until further order of the Court.

3 3. All proceedings in this action are STAYED until four
4 weeks from the date an attorney is appointed to represent Plaintiff
5 in this action, or until the Court otherwise lifts the stay.

6 IT IS SO ORDERED.
