15 Having considered Defendant EMC Mortgage Corporation's motion
 16 to exceed twenty-five pages in its motions for summary judgment
 17 and to decertify the class, Plaintiffs Armando and Melania
 18 Plascencia's opposition thereto and the parties' stipulation to
 19 change the briefing and hearing schedule for dispositive motions,
 20 the Court finds good cause to modify the case management order and
 21 set the following schedule for these motions:

22 Deadline for Plaintiffs to file their motion for 23 summary judgment, in a brief of thirty pages or less.	Friday, June 29, 2012
24 Deadline for Defendants to file their cross- 25 motions for summary judgment, motions to decertify the class and opposition to Plaintiffs' 26 motion for summary judgment.	Friday, July 13, 2012
27 The motions and opposition shall be addressed in 28 a single brief of sixty pages or less. To the extent possible, Defendants shall file a single joint brief on behalf of more than one, or all,	

1	Defendants, with separate sections to address individual differences as needed.	
2	Deadline for Plaintiffs to file their reply in support of their motion for summary judgment and their oppositions to Defendants' cross-motions.	Friday, July 27, 2012
3	The reply and oppositions shall be addressed in the same brief of thirty pages or less.	
4		
5	Deadline for Defendants to file their replies in support of their cross-motions for summary judgment and motions to decertify the class.	Thursday, August 9, 2012
6	The reply brief shall not exceed fifteen pages. To the extent possible, Defendants shall file a single joint brief on behalf of more than one, or all, Defendants, with separate sections to address individual differences as needed.

10	Deadline for the parties to file a joint case management conference statement.	Thursday, August 16, 2012
11		
12	Hearing on motions for summary judgment and to decertify class, and further case management conference.	Thursday, August 23, 2012 at 2:00 p.m.

14 The Court will entertain a stipulation to change the briefing
15 schedule, provided that opposing briefs are filed in series as
16 described above, not contemporaneously, with as little repetition
17 as possible, and that the parties' briefing is completed at least
18 two weeks prior to the hearing date.

19 The final pretrial conference is currently scheduled for
20 October 22, 2012, and the five day jury trial in this matter is
21 set to begin on November 5, 2012. Because the Court grants the
22 parties' stipulation to change the date for the dispositive motion
23 hearing, the Court notes that the dates for the final pretrial
24 conference and trial may need to be continued.
