9	The Northern District of California has established a Pro Se Prisoner Settlement Program.		
10	Certain prisoner civil rights cases may be referred to a neutral magistrate judge for prisoner		
11	settlement proceedings. The proceedings will consist of one or more conferences as determined by		
12	Magistrate Judge Nandor Vadas. The conferences shall be conducted at California State Prison -		
13	Solano.		
14	On March 10, 2010, the present pro se civil right action was referred to Magistrate Judge		
15	Vadas for settlement proceedings pursuant to the Pro Se Prisoner Settlement Program. On August		
16	3, 2010, the parties met for a settlement conference and were unable to reach an agreement.		
17	On August 25, 2010, the Court referred the case for further settlement proceedings before		
18	Judge Vadas. On December 29, 2010, a settlement conference was held, and the case was		
19	partially settled with respect to Defendant Tootell. At that settlement conference, the remaining		
20	Defendants claim they extended "a extremely generous settlement offer" to Plaintiff. (Defs.' EOT		
21	Req. at 2.) However, Plaintiff declined it.		
22	In an Order dated March 31, 2011, the present case was referred again to Magistrate Judge		
23	Vadas for further settlement proceedings. The settlement conference was set to take place on June 1,		
24	2011.		
25	On April 21, 2011, Defendants requested that the June 1, 2011 settlement conference be		
26	continued. On that same day, the Court granted Defendants' request and rescheduled the settlement		
27	conference for July 26, 2011.

On July 13, 2011 -- less than two weeks before the July 26, 2011 settlement conference --Defendants filed a joint motion for an extension of time to conduct the settlement conference. Defendants also request that their attorneys be allowed to attend the settlement conference telephonically.

Having considered the papers filed in support of the Defendants' request for an extension, the
Court finds that an extension of time to conduct the settlement conference is inappropriate.
Defendants have already received a previous two-month extension, and their current request is
untimely. Furthermore, Defendants do not give sufficient reasons to warrant allowing them to attend
the settlement conference telephonically.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Defendants' motion for an extension of time to
conduct the settlement conference (docket no. 320) is DENIED. Defendants' request to appear
telephonically is also DENIED. The settlement conference will be held as scheduled on Tuesday,
July 26, 2011 at 9:00 AM. It shall be conducted at California State Prison - Solano with
Defendants and/or the representative for Defendants attending in person.

The Clerk of the Court shall serve a copy of this Order on Magistrate Judge Vadas in Eureka, California.

This Order terminates Docket no. 320.
