Petitioner has filed a pro se petition for a writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. On that same date, the Clerk of the Court sent Petitioner a notice directing him to pay the filing fee or to file a completed in forma pauperis (IFP) application. Petitioner filed an IFP application; however, Petitioner did not file copies of the Certificate of Funds and prisoner trust account statement.

The Court cannot conduct an initial review of this matter until Petitioner has either paid the filing fee or submitted a complete IFP application. See 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a) (a party is permitted to file a civil action in federal court without prepayment of fees or security if he makes affidavit that he is unable to pay such fees or give security therefor). If the


1 petitioner is a prisoner who alleges that he is unable to pay the  
2 full filing fee at the time of filing, he must submit: (1) an  
3 affidavit that includes a statement of all assets he possesses, and  
4 (2) a certified copy of the trust fund account statement for the  
5 prisoner for the six-month period immediately preceding the filing  
6 of the action, obtained from the appropriate official of each  
7 prison at which the prisoner is or was confined. See id.  
8 § 1915(a)(1), (2). If the Court determines that the petitioner is  
9 unable to pay the full filing fee at the time of filing, the  
10 petitioner will be granted leave to proceed IFP.

11 Therefore, before the Court will proceed to review the  
12 complaint Petitioner is hereby ORDERED to file copies of the  
13 Certificate of Funds and prisoner trust account statement. He  
14 shall include with these documents a clear indication that it is  
15 for the above-referenced case number, C 07-06327 CW (PR).  
16 Petitioner shall do so within thirty (30) days of the date of this  
17 Order.

18 Failure to file copies of Petitioner's Certificate of Funds  
19 and prisoner trust account statement as ordered herein by the  
20 thirty-day deadline shall result in the dismissal of this action  
21 without prejudice.

22 IT IS SO ORDERED.
