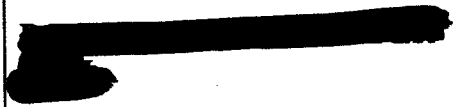


The Court having considered the parties' Joint Administrative Motion to Unseal Case and finding the motion to be supported by good cause,
