13 For the reasons set forth in this Court's order dated
14 November 21, 2014, Weiping Chen's third party claim is DENIED,
15 Midland Innovations, NV's objection to Chen's undertaking is
16 SUSTAINED and Midland's motion for order for sale of dwelling is
17 GRANTED. As the prevailing party, Midland shall recover its costs
18 from Chen. Any appeal must be taken within thirty days after
19 entry of this judgment. See Fed. R. App. P. 4(a)(1)(a). Midland
20 having withdrawn its motion to lift the injunction currently in
21 place to prevent the sale of the dwelling, that injunction remains
22 in effect pending appeal. The injunction will be lifted and the
23 dwelling sold if this judgment is affirmed.
