12 On September 17, 2010, the Court granted Leroy Paul Lujan's
13 pro se Petition for a Writ of Habeas Corpus under 28 U.S.C. § 2254
14 challenging a February 15, 2007 decision of the California Board of
15 Parole Hearings to deny him parole. (Doc. No. 13.) On September
16 28, 2010, Respondent filed a notice of appeal. (Doc. No. 15.)

17 In the interests of justice, the Court is authorized to
18 appoint counsel to a habeas petitioner who is financially unable to
19 obtain representation. See 18 U.S.C. § 3006A(g). Thus, if
20 Petitioner would like to be represented by counsel and cannot
21 afford to retain counsel, he may submit a motion for appointment of
22 counsel along with a completed in forma pauperis application, a
23 copy of which is enclosed, for the Court's consideration.
