Petitioner, a state prisoner, has filed this petition for a writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. He has paid the \$5.00 filing fee. It does not appear from the face of the petition that it is without merit. Good cause appearing, the Court hereby issues the following orders:

19 1. The Clerk of the Court shall serve a copy of this Order 20 and the petition and all attachments thereto upon Respondent and 21 Respondent's attorney, the Attorney General of the State of 22 California. The Clerk shall also serve a copy of this Order on 23 Petitioner at his current address.

United States District Court For the Northern District of California Answer a copy of all portions of the relevant state records that
 have been transcribed previously and that are relevant to a
 determination of the issues presented by the petition.

3. If Petitioner wishes to respond to the Answer, he shall
do so by filing a Traverse with the Court and serving it on
Respondent within <u>sixty (60) days</u> of his receipt of the Answer.
Should Petitioner fail to do so, the petition will be deemed
submitted and ready for decision <u>sixty (60) days</u> after the date
Petitioner is served with Respondent's Answer.

10 Respondent may file a motion to dismiss on procedural 4. 11 grounds in lieu of an Answer, as set forth in the Advisory 12 Committee Notes to Rule 4 of the Rules Governing Section 2254 If Respondent files such a motion, Petitioner shall file 13 Cases. 14 with the Court and serve on Respondent an opposition or statement 15 of non-opposition to the motion within sixty (60) days of receipt of the motion, and Respondent shall file with the Court and serve 16 17 on Petitioner a reply within fifteen (15) days of receipt of any 18 opposition.

19 5. It is Petitioner's responsibility to prosecute this case.
20 Petitioner must keep the Court and Respondent informed of any
21 change of address and must comply with the Court's orders in a
22 timely fashion. Petitioner must also serve on Respondent's counsel
23 all communications with the Court by mailing a true copy of the
24 document to Respondent's counsel.

25 6. Extensions of time are not favored, though reasonable26 extensions will be granted. Any motion for an extension of time


