**SECOND ORDER DIRECTING  
PLAINTIFFS TO SUBMIT  
CHAMBERS COPIES IN  
COMPLIANCE WITH GENERAL  
ORDER 45 AND THE COURT'S  
STANDING ORDERS**

9 On November 25, 2009, Plaintiffs electronically filed an opposition and supporting  
10 declarations. (Dkt. ##76-79.) However, Plaintiffs has failed to comply with General Order 45 and  
11 the Court's Standing Orders by failing to deliver to the Clerk's Office "no later than noon on the  
12 business day following the day that the papers are filed electronically, one paper copy of each  
13 document that is filed electronically . . . marked 'Chambers Copy' and . . . clearly marked with the  
14 judge's name, case number, and 'Chambers Copy-Do Not File.'" *See* General Order 45 § VI.G; *see*  
15 *also* Case Management Standing Order, Magistrate Judge Maria-Elena James, ¶ 6. Plaintiffs are  
16 hereby ORDERED to comply with General Order 45 and the Court's Standing Orders by  
17 immediately submitting a chambers copy, **with exhibits and appropriate tab dividers if**  
18 **necessary**, of the above-referenced documents.

19 The Court has previously advised Plaintiffs of the failure to comply with General Order 45  
20 and the Court's Standing Order in connection with earlier-filed documents. (*See* Dkt. #66.) Parties  
21 are expected to comply with court rules without repeated reminders. Accordingly, Plaintiffs are  
22 hereby advised that the Court will impose sanctions, including (but not limited to) striking from the  
23 record any electronically-filed document of which a chambers copy has not been timely provided to  
24 the Court.
