I, Allison Altersohn, declare as follows:

- 1. I am an attorney with the law firm of King & Spalding LLP, counsel for Plaintiff Google Inc. ("Google") in the above-captioned action. I submit this Declaration in support of Google Inc's Motion to Shorten Time filed concurrently herewith under separate cover. I have personal knowledge of all facts stated herein and, if sworn as a witness, I could and would testify completely thereto.
- 2. On August 9, 2010, the United States Patent and Trademark Office ("USPTO") granted Google's request for *inter partes* reexamination of U.S. Patent No. 7,289,386 ("the '386 Patent"). A true and correct copy of the USPTO's Order Granting Request for *Inter Partes* Reexamination of U.S. Patent No. 7,289,386, which was mailed on August 9, 2010, is attached as Exhibit A hereto.
- 3. In granting the request, the USPTO found seven (7) substantial new questions of patentability affecting some or all of claims 1-12 of the '386 Patent based on multiple prior art references. Specifically with respect to asserted claims 1 and 11 in the present case, four of the substantial questions of patentability affect claim 1 of the '386 Patent and two of the substantial new questions of patentability affect claim 11 of the '386 Patent.
- 4. Google filed concurrently herewith a motion to stay this case until the current reexamination of the '386 Patent is concluded.
- 5. The Court is currently scheduled to conduct a hearing concerning the parties' pending motions for summary judgment on September 14, 2010. (D.I. 177.)
- 6. The Court is currently scheduled to conduct the pretrial conference for this matter on October 19, 2010. (D.I. 81.)
