

1 B. <u>Discovery Deadline</u>

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2	Because Plaintiff's deposition is being delayed, the Court recommends that the presiding
3	judge continue the discovery deadline by two weeks <i>i.e.</i> , from June 26, 2009, to July 10, 2009,
4	without changing any other hearing or trial dates. This will ensure that Defendants incur no
5	prejudice from the delayed deposition. It appears that this change can be accommodated without
6	affecting the presiding judge's dispositive motion and trial schedule.
7	This order disposes of Docket Nos. 47 and 58.
