



1 unintelligible complaints, the Court finds that granting Plaintiff leave to amend would be futile.

2 Accordingly, Plaintiff's incomprehensible complaints are DISMISSED as frivolous because  
3 they are without an arguable basis in law. See Jackson v. Arizona, 885 F.2d 639, 641 (9th Cir.  
4 1989) (a complaint that is totally incomprehensible is subject to dismissal as frivolous for lacking an  
5 arguable basis in law). Any completed applications for leave to proceed in forma pauperis are  
6 DENIED. All other pending motions are TERMINATED. The Clerk of the Court shall close the  
7 files.
