Counsel for Plaintiff and Specially Appearing Defendant appeared for a hearing on the 15 motion on January 22, 2009, at 1:00 p.m. 16 Having considered the motion, the briefs, the affidavits and exhibits, and the oral arguments 17 of counsel, the Court finds the Plaintiff is not entitled to injunctive relief. For the reasons stated at 18 the hearing, the Plaintiff has not demonstrated a likelihood of success on its claims for copyright 19 infringement, statutory unfair competition, intentional or negligent interference with prospective 20 economic relations, and for violations of the Electronic Communications Privacy Act and the 21 Computer Fraud and Abuse Act. In addition, the plaintiff has not demonstrated it will suffer 22 irreparable harm absent injunctive relief, or that the balance of hardships tip in its favor. A & M 23 Records v.
