3 good cause appearing it is hereby ORDERED:

- 4 1. With respect to the remaining witnesses to be provided by Defendant Union City in  
5 Fobbs I pursuant to plaintiffs' notice of deposition under Rule 30(b)(6), the parties  
6 should follow the usual rule that each witness may be deposed only for a total of

9 2010.
  - 10 2. Plaintiffs' motion to compel answers to questions asked of witness Derting is  
11 GRANTED. Plaintiffs motion to compel answers to questions asked of witness  
12 Musgrove is GRANTED as to Topics 4 and 5, and DENIED as to topics 9, 10 and 11.
  - 13 3. No counsel or party may disrupt any deposition.
  - 14 4. The deposition of Mr. Moore shall take place as soon as possible, but if no other date  
15 is feasible the deposition shall take place on July 30, 2010.
