16	On July 27, 2009, Defendant ¹ filed a Motion for Attorneys' Fees [Docket No. 28], which it	
17	noticed for hearing on October 6, 2009. For the reasons set forth below, the Court GRANTS	
18	Defendant's Motion for Attorneys' Fees.	
19 20	This Court has reviewed the motion, the declaration of Fred Hickman in support thereof,	
20	and the Deed of Trust and Note that formed the basis of the underlying action. The Court notes that	
22	Defendant's counsel declares that he met and conferred in person with Plaintiff's counsel on July	
23	16, 2009, prior to filing the motion. Moreover, Defendant's counsel declares that he provided	
24	Plaintiff's counsel with a print out detailing the fees that are the subject of this motion. [Hickman	
25	Decl. at 2:10-17]. Defense counsel subsequently filed this motion seeking attorney fees. Plaintiff

1	filed no opposition to Defendant's motion. Under the Court's standing orders, Plaintiff's opposition		
2	was due September 15, 2009. To date, no opposition to the motion has been filed. Finally, the		
3	Court's standing orders inform the parties that failure to oppose a motion "shall constitute a consent		
4	to the granting of the motion."		
5 6	Based upon the above facts, the Court finds good cause to grant Defendant's fee request.		
7	The Court refers this matter to a Magistrate Judge of this Court for determination of the appropriate		
8	amount to be awarded. Plaintiff should be provided the opportunity to be heard, if he chooses,		
9	concerning the reasonable amount of fees awarded. Accordingly,		
10	IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT Defendant's motion for attorneys' fees is GRANTED.		
11	The instant action is referred to the Chief Magistrate Judge or her designee for a determination of		
12	the appropriate amount of reasonable attorney fees to be awarded.
