Defendants Belkin International, Inc., Cisco-Linksys, LLC, D-Link Systems, Inc.,
NETGEAR, Inc., and SMC Networks, Inc. (collectively "Defendants") have submitted an
administrative request to seal portions of their Reply in Support of Motion to Preclude Plaintiff
From Asserting a Theory of Infringement Under the Doctrine of Equivalents and To Strike
Portions of Dr. Dahlberg's Expert Report Discussing the Doctrine of Equivalents. The request is
