**STIPULATION AND [PROPOSED]  
 ORDER TO RESCHEDULE CASE  
 MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE**

1 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by Plaintiffs ExcelStor Technology, Inc.,  
2 ExcelStor Technology Limited, ExcelStor Group Limited, ExcelStor Great Wall Technology  
3 Limited, and Shenzhen ExcelStor Technology Limited (collectively referred to as “ExcelStor”) and  
4 Defendant Papst Licensing GmbH & Co. KG (“Papst”), through their respective counsel and  
5 pursuant to Civil Local Rules 6-2, 7-12 and 16-2, as follows:

7 WHEREAS, ExcelStor filed the captioned action on May 12, 2009;

8 WHEREAS, this Court initially scheduled the Case Management Conference for August 27,  
9 2009;

10 WHEREAS, Papst filed a motion on July 17, 2009 to dismiss the ExcelStor’s complaint;

11 WHEREAS, ExcelStor filed an Amended Complaint on July 31, 2009;

12 WHEREAS, Papst then withdrew its motion to dismiss the initial complaint in the captioned  
13 action, and filed a new motion to dismiss the Amended Complaint;  
14

15 WHEREAS, this Court rescheduled the Case Management Conference for October 22, 2009  
16 based on a stipulated request of the parties, as a result of Papst withdrawing its initial motion to  
17 dismiss and filing a new one after ExcelStor filed an Amended Complaint;

18 WHEREAS, in an August 26, 2009 Order (Dkt. No. 37), this Court set a detailed schedule  
19 for briefing and resolving the Rule 12(b)(1), (2) and (6) issues raised in Papst’s motion to dismiss in  
20 several stages;

21  
22 WHEREAS, pursuant to its Order of August 26, 2009, the Court first will hear oral argument  
23 on October 21, 2009 on the subject matter jurisdiction and failure to state a claim portions of Papst’s  
24 motion to dismiss;

25 WHEREAS, pursuant to its Order of August 26, 2009, if the Court determines that there is  
26 subject matter jurisdiction, there is a schedule for completing briefing on ExcelStor’s motion for  
27 personal jurisdictional discovery that is measured from the date of the Court’s decision as to whether

1 there is subject matter jurisdiction;

2 WHEREAS, pursuant to its Order of August 26, 2009, if the Court grants the discovery  
3 motion, there is a schedule for conducting the discovery and then completing briefing on the  
4 personal jurisdiction portion of Papst's motion to dismiss, that is measured from the date of the  
5 Court's decision on the discovery motion;  
6

7 WHEREAS, pursuant to its Order of August 26, 2009, if the Court does not grant the  
8 discovery motion, there is a schedule for completing briefing on the personal jurisdiction portion of  
9 Papst's motion to dismiss, that is measured from the date of the Court's decision on the discovery  
10 motion; and

11 WHEREAS, in view of the pending motions and the schedule set by the Court's Order of  
12 August 26, 2009, it is desirable to continue the Case Management Conference that is currently  
13 scheduled for October 22, 2009, and briefly to discuss appropriate timing for a Case Management  
14 Conference at the hearing of Papst's motion to dismiss on October 21, 2009;

15  
16 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED between ExcelStor and Papst that, subject to the Court's  
17 approval, the Case Management Conference be removed from the docket on October 22, 2009 and  
18 its timing be addressed at the hearing of Papst's motion to dismiss on October 21, 2009. This Court  
19 initially scheduled a Case Management Conference for August 27, 2009, and the impact on the  
20 overall schedule of this case due to the requested rescheduling of the Case Management Conference  
21 will depend on the new schedule set by the Court.
