**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANT'S
MOTION TO EXTEND THE DEADLINE
TO FILE DISPOSITIVE MOTION**

21 The Motion to Extend the Deadline to File Dispositive Motion by defendant A.A.
22 LAMARQUE and all related pleadings were submitted to this Court. The Court, having read and
23 considered the motion and related papers in this matter, and all other matters presented to the Court,
24 and good cause appearing therefore, hereby GRANTS the motion and makes the following an Order
25 of this Court:

26 IT IS ORDERED that Defendant shall file a motion for summary judgment or other
27 dispositive motion no later than **ninety (90) days after this motion is granted.** The motion shall be
28 supported by adequate factual documentation and, if applicable, shall conform in all respects to
Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 56. If Defendant is of the opinion that this case cannot be resolved

1 by dispositive motion, he shall so inform the Court prior to the date the motion is due. All papers
2 filed with the Court shall be promptly served on Plaintiff.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Plaintiff's opposition to the dispositive motion shall be
4 filed with the Court and served on Defendant no later than sixty (60) days after the date on which
5 Defendant's motion is filed. Plaintiff is referred to the Court's Order of Service filed May 7, 2010,
6 at Docket No. 8, regarding summary judgment.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Defendant's reply brief shall be filed no later than thirty
8 (30) days after the date Plaintiff's opposition is filed.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the motion shall be deemed submitted as of the date the reply
10 brief is due. No hearing will be held on the motion unless the Court so orders at a later date.

11 IT IS SO ORDERED.
