11	pauperis was provided with the notice, along with a return envelope. Plaintiff was informed
12	that any case in which he did not either pay the fee or file an IFP application within thirty
13	days would be dismissed.
14	More than thirty days have passed and plaintiff has not paid the filing fees or filed
15	IFP applications. These cases therefore are <b>DISMISSED</b> without prejudice. The clerk shall
16	file a copy of this order in each case listed in the caption above and shall closes the files.
