1 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Plaintiff's request for courtesy 2 copies of Defendants' dispositive motions and his request for an 3 extension of time in which to file his oppositions to Defendants' dispositive motions are GRANTED. The Clerk of the Court shall mail Plaintiff a copy of Defendants' dispositive motions (eighteen pages of Docket no. 85 in Case No. C 07-04277 CW (PR) and twenty-six pages of Docket no. 38 in Case No. C 09-3003 CW (PR)), not including any attached exhibits or declarations because they exceed one hundred pages. Defendants shall serve Plaintiff with another copy of the aforementioned exhibits -- attached to Docket no. 85 in Case No. C 07-04277 CW (PR) and to Docket no. 38 in Case No. C 09-3003 CW (PR) -- no later than three (3) days from the date of this Order.

Plaintiff may file his oppositions to Defendants' dispositive motions up to <u>February 28, 2011</u>.

16 If Defendants wish to file reply briefs, they shall do so no
17 later than <u>fifteen (15) days</u> after the date Plaintiff's oppositions
18 are filed.

19 <u>No further extensions of time will be granted in this case</u>
20 <u>absent exigent circumstances</u>.

22 (PR) and Docket no. 52 in Case No. C 09-3003 CW (PR).
